- Helping them to find the services that they need;
- Providing people with information about health issues;
- Supporting them to make changes in their lifestyle that will improve their health.

The successful candidate for the post of **Health Trainer** will have passed City and Guilds 3075 Certificate for Health Trainers, or will be working towards this qualification.

No formal qualifications are required to apply for the post of **Trainee Health Trainer** as full training and the gaining of a City & Guilds qualification will be a requirement. However, the successful applicant should be able to demonstrate:

- A good knowledge of the community in which they will be working;
- Good communications skills;
- Basic standards of numeracy and literacy;
- An ability to work with people both individually and in groups;
- Good time management and self management skills.
