Derby Food 4 Thought Alliance (DF4TA)	Derby Food 4 Thought Alliance (DF4TA) provides limited SIM card support to newly arrived individuals living in Laverstoke Court or city-centre-based hotels. The cards are provided: • via a QR code available from Ben at Upbeat Communities on a Thursday at hotels, and • via Migrant Help for those living at Laverstoke Court Eligibility To receive SIM card support, you must: • Have arrived in the UK within the last 4 weeks • Have no access to a SIM card that provides calls and texts • Have your own working mobile phone (DF4TA does not provide mobile phones) How to Access Support • SIM card appointments are available through DF4TA on Tuesdays • You must attend on the date and time provided • If you are unable to attend, you will have to reapply • Once you have submitted the form you will receive a instant message with information on what to do next Collecting Your SIM Card • Please bring your mobile phone with you when you attend • Please bring Home Office paperwork or Identification Document with your picture on. Please bring physical ID not a picture on your phone • You are welcome to stay for a hot drink and a biscuit while your SIM card is prepared and activated • A member of the team will explain how long your SIM card package will remain active and what is included • Please note that we will not give you a SIM card if you turn up with no phone or Identification	Paul Brookhouse on 26/8/26
