Activities Programme

The Forward Vision Club will offer a diverse programme of activities designed to build confidence, independence and practical life skills through fun, engaging experiences.

Young people will take part in:



Cooking sessions



Budgeting challenges



Gardening projects



Homework support



Myth-busting nights

Developing critical thinking and everyday skills.

Creative Opportunities

Music remixing and group dance challenges encourage expression and teamwork.

Physical Activities

Obstacle courses, Silent Ball, and problem-solving missions—promote resilience, cooperation, and wellbeing.

Social Activities

Social activities, such as Xbox sessions, team games, and group challenges, help foster friendships and a strong sense of belonging within a safe, supervised environment.

Building Connections and Skills

These informal moments are key to building trust, improving social skills, and helping young people feel more connected to their peers and the wider community.



"Learning by stealth"

Our Approach

Many of these activities are designed so that young people "learn by stealth," developing communication, leadership and problem-solving skills.

This approach helps young people build confidence naturally, without the pressure of formal learning settings.

The programme will remain flexible and youth-led, with activities shaped by the interests and ideas of the young people who attend.

Residential



The residential will take place at the end of the 5 to 6 month programme and is offered to participants who have shown consistent commitment, positive engagement and responsible behaviour throughout the club sessions.

As a key part of the Forward Vision Club, the residential provides young people with a memorable and transformative experience.

Residential Activities

Across the residential, participants will take part in a range of outdoor adventure activities such as canoeing, abseiling, and bouldering. They will also engage in team challenges, nature walks, campfire sessions, and guided reflection.

A Lasting Impact

These activities are designed to strengthen communication skills, encourage leadership, and deepen young people's connection with themselves, their peers, and the natural environment.



Core Life Skills Taught



The residential is about learning skills that help young people grow, work with others, and feel confident.

Throughout the activities, you'll get to explore and practice important life skills like:

 **Confidence and self belief**

 **Communication and teamwork**

 **Managing emotions and decision making**

 **Basic money skills**
(budgeting, saving)

 **Goal setting and planning for the future**

 **Employability basics**
(time keeping, responsibility, mindset)
